## Making Inclusive Education Happen.

This is the easy read summary of 'Achieving Inclusive Education' document by The Coalition for Inclusive Education.



The Coalition for Inclusive Education is a group of Disabled people and allies who are interested in making Inclusive Education happen.



The Coalition for Inclusive Education is supported by The Alliance for Inclusive Education.



The Coalition want to see an 'Inclusive Education Act' in the UK. This will help get inclusion, justice and a right to education for all Disabled students.



The United Nations
Convention on the Rights of
Persons with Disabilities
(UNCRPD), was signed by
the UK in 2009.



This guarantees inclusive education for **Disabled** students and pupils.



But the UK does not follow this because it keeps allowing segregated learning places, like **special schools.** 



This means that lots of UK Disabled students and pupils experience discrimination.



The Coalition for Inclusive Education, a group helped by ALLFIE since 2024, says this **should change.** 



# They say that we need an **Inclusive Education Act.**



This would help give a **right to education** for all Disabled pupils and students.



The Coalition for Inclusive Education says that **there are nine things** that need to happen to improve the situation for Disabled pupils and students.



### 1. A RIGHT TO INCLUSIVE EDUCATION

Make a law that says all Disabled and Deaf students have the right to go to regular schools with everyone else.



This law should follow the **UN rules** and make sure students get the help they need to stay in school.



The law should withdraw all reservations to **Article 24** of the UNCRPD.



This says;

'Every person with a disability has the right to education without discrimination and on the basis of equal opportunity'.



### 2. STOP SEGREGATED EDUCATION

Stop using special schools and make all schools inclusive for everyone.



Use money from special schools to **help all schools** include everyone.



### 3. ENABLE ACCESSIBILITY

Make sure all schools and places of learning have what they need to help Disabled people.



This means making things easy to use and giving extra help when needed. Everyone should be able to learn together.



### 4. A CURRICULUM FOR ALL

Make a new school plan and learning programme, a curriculum that works for everyone, especially Disabled pupils.



Change tests to be **fair for all**.



Stop using **Education & Health Care Plans** and try
a new way that helps
everyone learn better.



### 5. MONITOR AND PROMOTE INCLUSION

Create **one system to check** and manage
Inclusive Education.

This system makes sure all schools include everyone and **give support** to all students.

Families should not have to ask or **fight for help.** 







# 6. MORE DISABLED PEOPLE AS TEACHERS

Get more Disabled people working as **teachers and helpers** in schools.



Make sure they get the right help and support so they feel welcome and can do their jobs well.



### 7. SKILLS FOR INCLUSION

Make a plan to help teachers **learn more** about Inclusive Education.

This plan should teach them how to **include all** students in learning.



Make sure all teaching courses have lessons on Inclusive Education.



Keep helping **teachers** to learn more.



### 8. REPRESENTING DISABLED PEOPLE

Increase the visibility and representation of disability across the curriculum and learning context.



Promote a **positive culture** of Disabled people to include their histories, realities and diversity.



### 9. A PROACTIVE APPROACH

We need to **take action** to stop unfair treatment and leaving people out in schools.



This includes helping people who face different kinds of **unfair treatment** at the same time.



The Coalition for Inclusive Education believe that if we do these **nine things**, it will help get inclusion, justice and a right to education for all Disabled students.
